During Reconciliation Week 2007 ReconciliACTION will be holding a National Youth Forum and Arts Showcase at the University of Technology, Sydney. The event will bring together Indigenous and non-Indigenous young people from across Australia to participate in discussions about reconciliation, to learn about Indigenous cultures, to develop their skills, and to be entertained! The Forum is part of a program of events being organised across the country to mark the 40th anniversary of the 1967 Referendum.

Young people participating in the National ReconciliACTION Youth Forum will have the opportunity to:

- See and participate in performances and exhibitions which celebrate contemporary Indigenous art and cultures
- Hear from inspiring speakers currently working at the local, state and national level to promote reconciliation and Indigenous rights
- Participate in workshops and discussions including creative ways to overcome racism and build community awareness

All young people aged 16-29 years are welcome to attend. There are some limited scholarships available to assist with travel costs. See contact details below.

ReconciliACTION is a network of Indigenous and non-Indigenous young Australians from across metropolitan, regional and remote Australia. We come together to work on projects and campaigns. Our name - 'ReconciliACTION' - reflects the belief that Reconciliation has to be about more than just words. It is about making changes through action. ReconciliACTION is a not-for-profit, non-partisan volunteer group which was initiated and is entirely run by young people.
